

JUNE 8th SCHOOL MESSENGER – END OF YEAR REMINDERS

Dear Corpus Christi School families:

This past week was the beginning of June and preparation continues for the final week of school with all our celebrations and awards assemblies. **The last week of school (June 11-15) includes a number of schedule changes to accommodate end of year ceremonies, activities and teacher preparation for final grades and awards.**

FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS - In order for students to receive their report cards, each family is required to settle financial obligations, including balances due for any owed Family Service Hours, and return all textbooks and library books to school by Wednesday, June 13th.

STUDENT MEDICATIONS - Medications must be picked up in the office by parents on the last day, June 15th. Any medications left must be destroyed per Diocesan policy. If your child will be attending summer camp, you can talk to the nurse about leaving medications.

SUMMER CAMP – The week of June 18th will be our first week of summer camp. Campers will be divided into rising 1st and 2nd, 3rd-5th and 6th-8th with each group being capped at 20 campers due to field trips and the bus. Monday, June 11th, and Tuesday, June 12th – Full Days of School

 - Parents may arrive after 8:45 a.m. to set up.
 - **If your student is attending Extended Day, please send a bag lunch. Extended Day is available until 6:00 p.m.**

Friday, June 15th - Last Day of School for Grades 1-7, 11:00 a.m. Dismissal

- **All students wear their dress warm weather uniform.**
- Students report to school at their regular arrival time.
- **8:30 a.m.** - All School Mass and celebration of Mrs. Krafchek and Mrs. Landon's retirements.
- **9:30 a.m.** - End of year school awards, the announcement of the new student council and field day winners
 - Parents are invited to attend in the gym.
- **11:00 a.m. - Students will be dismissed from their homerooms and follow a normal dismissal procedure.**
 - Report cards will be sent home with students.
 - **It is important that students be picked up on time since there will be no after-school Extended Day.**
 - If a student is absent, families must contact the office to arrange a pickup time for report cards, personal belongings, etc.
 - A student's personal items and report cards will not be mailed.
